

The Greens have been married for 47 years; they have been missionaries in Taiwan since 1988. Bro. Green has church services at both the Tandz Bible Baptist Church and the Daya Bible Baptist Church, located in Taichung, a city in central Taiwan. This city is the second largest city in Taiwan, with over 2.8 million people.

Bro. Green frequently sends us news letters, almost every week. We reached out to the Greens, after not getting an update after the earthquake on April 3rd. Bro. Green answered saying they were praising the Lord for His goodness and protection. The earthquake affected the eastern and middle side of the island and the Greens were not aware of any churches affected. They've experienced some computer problems and unable to send out an update. Last month, the Greens passed out hundreds of church packets and gospel tracts. They appreciate our prayers and support.
